
TRAVEL INFORMATION TO DESTINATION


From Airport -

BUS – the x4 bus goes every 30 min from Airport 1. It takes about 35 min, including a 10-15 min walk to the venue.

Get off at the Publiju bus stop (15 stops, about 20-25 min). Head east on Vjal Ir-Re Dwardu VII. Turn left at Triton Fountain Bust Stop. Turn right and follow the road around the fountain. Continue straight onto Republic Street. Turn right (at the playground) onto Archbishop Street. Turn left (at S. Luigi) onto St Paul Street – the University of Malta, Valetta Campus will be on your Left.
